



## Board Meeting Synopsis for February 18, 2010

### Music:

The Music Director reported that a lot of the equipment used by the community is in need of repair or replacement. Specific needs and the cost factor will be reported at the next board meeting and shared with the Community.

### Spiritual Director

The spiritual director reported that we now have an assistant spiritual director, John Etcher from Ivy Memorial Baptist Church.

The spiritual director will host a luncheon for pastors that are members of the Community to discuss the Emmaus movement both locally and otherwise, and the different types of service opportunities that are available within TWE.

### Team Selection

The men's team and women's teams are in place and have begun training for the Spring walks.

### Registration/Weekends/Outreach

A cost study was presented concerning moving the walk from Airfield Conference Center to Triple R Ranch. It was found that it would be more cost efficient to keep the walks at Wakefield.

Outreach material is available (video, brochure) for those members of the community who want to "spread the word" about Emmaus with members of their home church.

### Finance

All accounts for the community are in place. The finance director is exploring the use of credit cards by teamers, sponsors, and pilgrims to pay for the walk. She also reported that we may need to look for a new attorney to assist the Community with its annual paperwork that is filed with the State.

### Agape

The agape director is developing a new international agape letter that each member of the community will be able to sign. The agape committee will meet at 5:30 before the gathering to work on agape projects. The Agape page on the TWE website now includes online sign-up for the weekend prayer vigils.

## Communications

Facebook is up and running and being well received.

## Documents

The document director reported that the current roster is up to 368 members and he is looking for many more. He is also looking for information from members of the community about walks, teams, and pilgrim lists for the earlier walks by our community.

## Lay director
